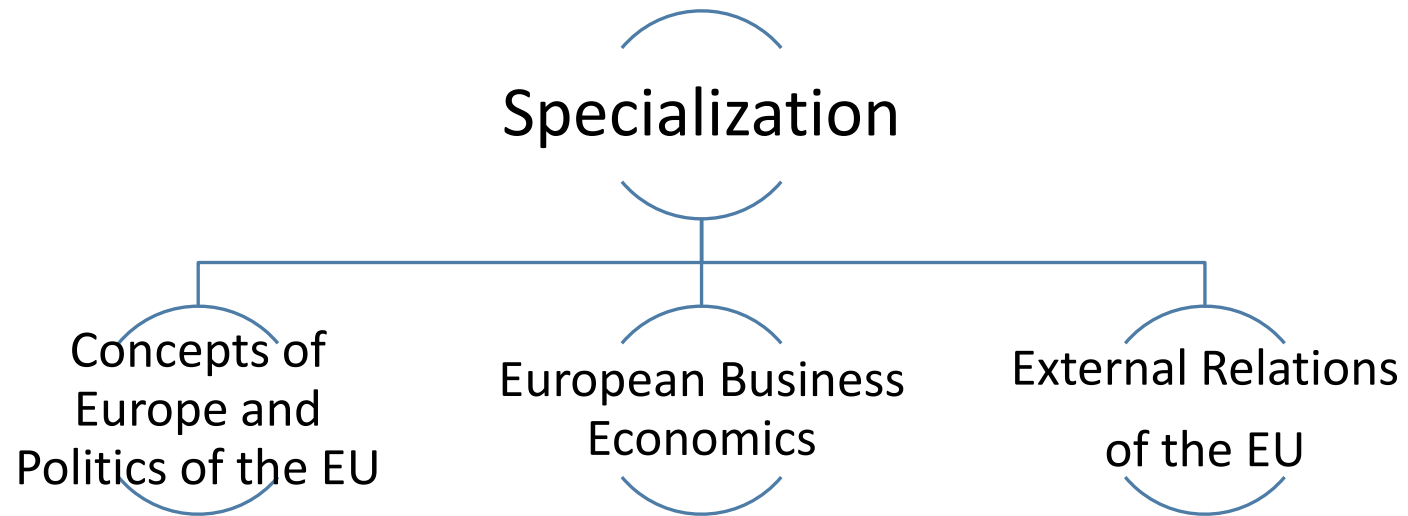

4. Instead of one 5 CP module, you can also do an internship (minimum of 3 weeks).
